Silent Auction Rules

The Silent Auction is a popular and fun activity designed to raise funds for the benefit of the **Brookfield Friends of the Library**. A wide variety of products and services have been donated by local businesses and residents for this event and are displayed during the event.

For each Silent Auction item, there is a bid sheet either next to the item or next to a description of the item if it is a gift certificate or other non-tangible item. You will write name and the amount you are willing to bid for that item on the bid sheet. There is no upper limit on any item. Any amount you elect to bid over the Fair Market Value of an item (where known) is tax-deductible. Bidding will continue on these items until the designated closing time. Please pay attention to minimum bid and raise amounts. You must follow these for your bid to be considered valid.

At closing time (8:45 p.m.), the bid sheets will be collected and the winning bidder will be determined.

What Are the Bidding Rules?

Bidding will begin at 6:30 p.m. and close at 8:45 p.m.

An auction clock will be designated and a countdown for the final minutes will be announced.

The stated values of items in the Silent Auction are based on information provided by donors or, in a very few cases, market values researched by the Friends. The Friends are not responsible for accuracy of donor-assigned values.



Silent Auction Rules

Minimum bids have been established for all items. In addition, pre-set increments for increasing bids have been set. Some items may have pre-bids on them. Bidding will start from this point.

You may bid as many times as you wish, providing your bids are above the current highest bid by the increment specified on the Bid Form. Please use the bid number located on the backside of your program. Once your bid is submitted, it becomes a legal contract to buy.

Some items have expiration dates, unchangeable special qualifications or restrictions. Please note these when bidding on these items. Refunds for unused purchases are not available.

The Brookfield Friends of the Library is a tax-exempt corporation under Internal Revenue Service Code section 501(c)(3). Therefore, bidders may be entitled to deduct a portion of payments for Silent Auction items as charitable contributions. Please consult your tax advisor regarding deductibility.

You've Won!!! Next Steps...

All winners will be announced at the end of the evening. If you are present, please proceed to check out to pay for your item and pick it up. Several staff help make this a fast and efficient process. If you are not present, you will be called within 24 hours to arrange payment and pick-up. It is the responsibility of the winner to claim their items.



Silent Auction Rules (cont.)

Check Out Procedures

All items must be claimed and paid for at the end of the Silent Auction on Friday evening if the winner is present.

Nothing will be released until payment is received.

Payments will be accepted in the form of cash or check.

Make checks payable to "**Friends of the Library**".

Each winner will receive a tax receipt letter along with their items at the end of the evening.
